

2022 Fairway Gorge Super Sprints Saturday 14 May

Race and Site Information

Fairway Gorge Super Sprints is the first FGPC dragon boat festival of the season, and is always a great way to begin a year of dragon boat racing. Quick and crazy, these 200M sprints give teams a chance to showcase the work you've put into training so far.

All paddlers must have a valid FGPC waiver completed or on file before participating in the event. Team check-ins begin at 9:00 am. All rosters must be submitted prior to race day on line, but if necessary team captains can bring any last-minute changes to their rosters at the event's 9am check-in. **The Drummer and Sterns' Meeting will be held at 9:30 am sharp** on the dock at FGPC on Saturday 14 May. All sterns are required to attend. Races, as per the accompanying Race Schedule, begin at 10 am sharp and racing concludes at 3:00 pm.

All teams will be racing **THREE times** throughout the day: a placement heat, followed by a semi final and then a final. There will be three mixed championship (medal) races for mixed crews and two consolation (non medal) races. There will be two championship (medal) races and two consolation (non medal) for women's crews.

It will be a busy and fun day of paddling!

Parking will be free in the large parkade at the end of Garbally Road (close to Bridge Street, see "3" on the accompanying parking map below) -- with enough room for all cars. Please use this parkade unless you have an overheight vehicle. See parking and event map below.

Sol Fine Foods (across the street from FGPC) will be open on race day and is located in the middle section of the 2900 block of Jutland Road. They'll have a dragon boat menu of quick-serve items. Teams often bring their own food and beverages (non-alcoholic) and locate these at their assigned tent sites at Paddlers' Village.

Paddlers' Village

Please bring your own 10X10 tent and chairs for your first-come-first-served space at Paddlers' Village. Tents can be assembled after 8.30am. Please note that this is a residential area, so keep music and other amplified sound to a minimum. FGPC's new Paddlers' Village location is at Selkirk Green Park, a greenspace located between Waterfront Crescent and Jackladder Lane, a short 250 meters away (a 2-minute walk) from the race site at FGPC. There is a map of the paddlers' village below.


About the Fairway Gorge Paddling Club Society (FGPC)
